The SCAN Foundation seeks to advance a coordinated and easily navigated system of high-quality services for older adults that preserve dignity and independence. To achieve our mission, the Foundation funds bold, catalytic, and impact-oriented projects that focus on the following areas:

- **Medicare-Medicaid Integration:** Transforming care for low-income older adults by integrating systems of care to improve quality while creating innovative financing.
- **Person-Centered Care:** Advancing services and supports based on needs and preferences of the person, placing quality of life on a level playing field with quality of care.
- **Long-Term Care Financing:** Supporting public policy development to establish affordable and viable long-term care financing options for working Americans.

### **How We Began**

The SCAN Foundation was created as an independent charitable organization in April 2008 through a \$205 million one-time contribution from the not-for-profit SCAN Health Plan.
